

Cheltenham Football Netball Club Safe Transport Policy

The Cheltenham Football Netball Club recognises the importance of holding a liquor licence, enabling it to generate income and to hold social functions. In doing so, we accept the responsibilities and expectations of the community in adhering to liquor licensing laws.

To ensure the aims of the club are upheld and that alcohol is managed responsibly by the club and its members, the following requirements will apply when alcohol is served at the club or during a club function:

- Bar staff shall encourage members and visitors to make alternate safe transport arrangements if they are considered to exceed 0.05 blood alcohol concentration (or 0.00 if probationary driver).
- Telephone calls will be made free of charge to arrange a taxi or other transport.
- Contact telephone numbers for taxi services will be clearly displayed.
- The club recommends members and visitors have both the uber and taxi app on their phone.
- In specific cases, where a designated driver nominated by the club has accepted responsibility to drive others home safely, the club will provide non-alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge.
- In specific cases, bar servers will be provided non-alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club (only for club bar staff).
- In specific cases and where available club transport will be provided to/from events
- Committee will pre-order taxis to arrive at the venue at the conclusion of the function.
- Committee will ensure the club is made a taxi hotspot after the conclusion of a club event.

The Cheltenham Football Netball Club shall ensure our members are aware of this policy and are encouraged to make alternative transport arrangements when consuming alcohol at functions

This policy will be reviewed 12 months from 01/01/17
